Overview

In this article, we will discuss how to join an instant meeting through an email invite.

Before joining a Zoom meeting on a computer or mobile device, you can download the Zoom app. Otherwise, you will be prompted to download and install Zoom when you click a join link.

You can also join a test meeting to familiarise yourself with Zoom.

Prerequisites

- Each meeting has a unique 9, 10, or 11-digit number called a <u>meeting ID</u> that will be required to join a Zoom meeting
- If you are joining via telephone, you will need the teleconferencing number provided



Google Chrome

- 1. Open Chrome.
- 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
- 3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.

- 4. Click Join.
 - If this is your first time joining from Google Chrome, you will be asked to open the Zoom client to join the meeting.
 - You can check Always open these types of links in the associated app to skip this step in the future.
 - Click Open Zoom Meetings (PC) or Open zoom.us (Mac).

- 1. Open Safari.
- 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
- 3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.

Microsoft Edge or Internet Explorer

- 1. Open Edge or Internet Explorer.
- 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
- 3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.

- 1. Open Firefox.
- 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
